### What does it all mean?

#### What is ISDN?

BT introduced ISDN in 1986, only one year after Connaught was born. Now, we're not going anywhere but ISDN has come to the end of the line. Quite literally.

ISDN stands for **Integrated Services Digital Network.** It's a digital telephone network that transmits voice and data through the UK's phone lines. The ISDN switch-off is simply the shutdown of the traditional telecommunications network.

BT have announced that they will have shut down all traditional phone lines by 2025. Which means that when it comes to the ISDN switch off, no-one's off the hook. So you will need to move any traditional landlines to IP (or Internet Protocol lines).

#### Why is it happening?

Communications and technology have advanced significantly over the past 30 years. Although some improvements have been made to the ISDN network, these have been overtaken by the progress of internet-based communications.

Internet Protocol (IP) simply means that calls and data are exchanged over the internet. Exchanging information over the internet is faster and gives greater flexibility for users too. With a nationwide infrastructure and investment in fast internet products, Internet Protocol is the modern alternative to the ISDN.

#### When do I need to act?

All traditional phone lines will be switched off by 2025.

#### **Dates & Deadlines**

From September 2023, ISDN lines will no longer be available for purchase. The switch off will be complete by December 2025.

However orders for new lines have already been stopped in some parts of the country. For example, in the Midlands, you can no longer purchase new ISDN lines in some areas of Birmingham, Solihull and Coventry. And as of 28th June 2020, copper lines are no longer available from 118 exchanges across the UK.

You can wait until your local exchange is switched off. Or you can take action and upgrade now. It's entirely up to you.

## How the rollout will happen

The ISDN is made up of lots (hundreds) of exchanges across the UK. A telephone exchange is essentially an intersection or a connection between two phone lines.

BT will confirm a Stop Sell date for each exchange. After that date (which will vary by region) no new ISDN lines or services can be purchased. Updates to existing lines will also not be possible.

It's worth bearing in mind that this doesn't just affect phone lines.

Any BT Openreach service that uses copper lines will be affected, including:

- Alarm systems
- CCTV
- Door entry systems
- EPOS machines
- Fax machines
- Modems
- PDQ machines

To make the switch-off possible, BT is busy rolling out the full fibre network (FTTP) across the UK to enable faster cloud-based telephony

### What Internet Protocol means for you
